

ClimbEUR support for courses

Fully paid-up members of ClimbEUR can obtain a financial support from the club to participate in climbing courses **subject to availability of funds** and at the discretion of the committee under the following **general conditions**:

- i. only courses taking place **in Belgium** qualify for financial support;
- ii. financial support is limited to a maximum of **50% of the total cost of the course(s)**;
- iii. the cumulative value of the financial support **cannot exceed 150 EUR/ member/ year**;
- iv. financial support is provided on a **first come first served** basis.

Additionally, **specific conditions** apply:

1. for **beginner courses**, the 50% reimbursement is made upon proof of payment and certification of participation.
 - a. When the course is provided by Vertical Dreams, the Belgian Alpin Club (CAB) or one of the Brussels indoor climbing gyms, no pre-approval from the ClimbEUR committee is necessary. However, to ensure continued availability of funds, the committee needs to be informed as soon as possible.
 - b. For all other beginner courses, i.e. offered by other accredited climbing entities (e.g. Escal'Pades), the member must obtain the pre-approval of the ClimbEUR committee.
 - c. In all cases, proof of participation / payment must be provided as soon as possible following the course. For courses occurring late in the year, the deadline for receiving this proof is 20th December.
2. for **advanced courses**, members must express their interest by including their name and choosing from a list of pre-selected courses indicated in an annual survey (available [here](#)). Once the minimum number of applicants is reached for a given course, the ClimbEUR committee will follow-up by identifying the period, confirming location, payment modalities etc.
